Assistant Engineer:-

- (a) Conducts the inspection of electrical installations as per the capacity/level described below:
 - (i) The sub stations of UHBVN/DHBVN and other Government departments up to 250KVA of other agencies having connected load up to 250KW and Diesel Generating Sets up to capacity of 250KVA.
 - (ii) Grant of Approval of Transmission lines up to capacity of 11KV line.
- (b) Conducts the investigation of non-fatal human accident.

Junior Engineer:-

Junior Engineer assist the Assistant Electrical Inspectors in the inspection of electrical installations, investigation of Fatal animal accidents and drafting of the inspection/investigation reports thereof.

Superintendent:-

Supervise the work of dealing Assistant under his control and also to ensure timely submission of all papers according to the priority of the authority.

To deal with the matter as per Rules and Acts. After dealing with such matters the same are submitted to the Superintendents/higher
